## JESUS SPEAKING

"I assure you and most solemnly say to you,  
unless one is born of water and the Spirit  
he cannot [ever] enter the kingdom of God.

That which is born of the flesh is flesh  
[the physical is merely physical],  
and that which is born of the Spirit is spirit."

# **SALVATION**

**BELIEVE**



Believe that Jesus died for your sins,  
was buried, and that  
God raised Jesus from the dead.

For God presented Jesus as the sacrifice for sin.

People are made right with God  
when they believe that Jesus sacrificed his life,  
shedding his blood.

– ROMANS 3:25 (NLT)

without the shedding of blood  
there is no forgiveness  
[neither release from sin and its guilt,  
nor cancellation of the merited punishment].

– HEBREWS 9:22 (AMP)

For it is by believing in your heart  
that you are made right with God,  
and it is by openly declaring your faith  
that you are saved.

– ROMANS 10:10 (NLT)

Forgiveness of sin is a gift from God



# SALVATION

CALL



– *a gift has to be accepted* –

Seek the Lord while He may be found;  
Call on Him [for salvation] while He is near.

– ISAIAH 55:6 (AMP)

**CALL**



Don't wait until later – accept His gift now.

"Today when you hear his voice,  
don't harden your hearts  
as Israel did when they rebelled."

– HEBREWS 3:15 (NLT)

Make sure that your own hearts  
are not evil and unbelieving,  
turning you away from the living God.

– HEBREWS 3:12b (NLT)

An example of what this looks like in action  
is found in Luke Chapter 23  
at the crucifixion of Jesus Christ,  
where two criminals were also crucified,  
one on His left and one on His right.

One of them blasphemed Jesus and scoffed...

## Example of a **HARD HEART & UNBELIEF**

One of the criminals hanging beside him scoffed,  
"So you're the Messiah, are you?  
Prove it by saving yourself – and us, too,  
while you're at it!"

– LUKE 23:39 (NLT)



## Example of **ABC's OF SALVATION**

But the other criminal protested,  
"Don't you fear God even when  
you have been sentenced to die?"

– LUKE 23:40 (NLT)



# Example of **ABC's OF SALVATION**

"We deserve to die for our crimes,  
but this man hasn't done anything wrong."

– LUKE 23:41 (NLT)



*He admitted he deserved to die for his crimes*



# Example of **ABC's OF SALVATION**

Then he said, "Jesus, remember me when you come into your Kingdom."

– LUKE 23:42 (NLT)



*He believed Jesus is who He said He is*



*He called upon Jesus to save him*



And Jesus replied, "I assure you,  
today you will be with me in paradise."

– LUKE 23:43 (NLT)

Are you ready to call upon Jesus  
to save you?

Everyone who calls  
on the name of the Lord will be saved.

– ROMANS 10:13 (NLT)

# SALVATION

If you are, then all you gotta do  
is call upon Jesus and tell Him you  
sincerely believe He is who He said He is.

And He is not looking for elegance of speech,  
Jesus is looking for sincerity in your heart.

Following is just an example –  
put it in your own words.  
Sincere belief is what's key.

# **SALVATION**

Dear Jesus,

I don't fully understand this all, but I do believe that You willingly sacrificed yourself on the cross to redeem me, to save me from eternal condemnation, and that You were buried and raised to life again.

I admit that I am a sinner and I want to turn from my sin and follow You. I want to place my faith in You alone as my Lord and Savior and accept your gift of eternal life and enter the Kingdom of God.

Thank you, Lord Jesus, for saving me.

You have just been adopted  
into the family of God  
– FOREVER –  
you cannot lose your salvation.

# SALVATION

During the Dispensation of Grace,

– the age we live in right now –

our salvation is sealed forever.

This is a promise given ONLY to  
born-again believers during the Age of Grace.

must remain steadfast in their faith  
and persevere through the persecution  
during the 70th Week of Daniel until the end

► **THE SECOND COMING OF JESUS CHRIST ENDS THE 70TH WEEK** ◀
